Spring time fun!



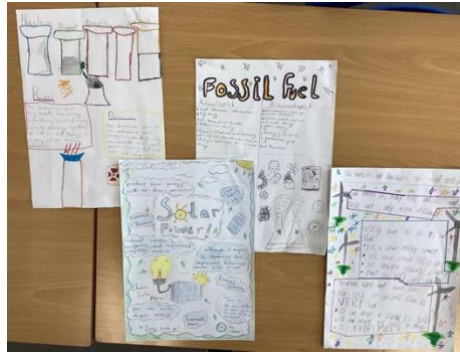

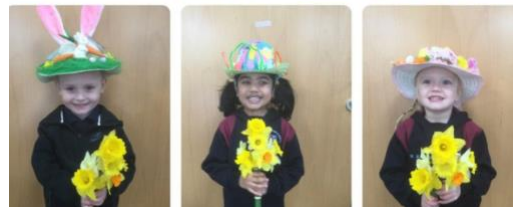
Year 2 Agents of Change ✨
