Sports Day

We are hoping to run our KS1 and KS2 Sports Day on Friday 7th June, the weather at the moment is not looking good and we will make a final decision on Thursday. Your child will bring home a Sports Day programme so you can see what your child will be doing when. Please enter through the main gate and make your way to the main field., where tea and coffee will be available.

Whole School Behaviour

A popular suggestion made by the children over the past few weeks has been for staff to look at improving the rewards system for the children. After discussions with staff and children we have reviewed our behaviour policy which can be found on the school website . The key changes are summarised below.

Rewards

The children have been introduced to the class Dojo system. Each child creates a character and is awarded 'dojos' for good behaviour, excellent work, reading at home, completing Homework etc, 'dojos' can be lost as well as earned and the children build up towards a total, 30 for older children and less for younger children. When the children have reached their target they are awarded a prize.

Weekly prizes awarded during celebration assembly on Friday include 'Pupil of the week' given for an excellent piece of work or contribution in class, and the Brilliant Behaviour Award. Each class also works together as a team to hit their class dojo target which when achieved results in a treat of the children's choosing, these are agreed with in advance with the teacher and can range from a trip out, to a 'movie' afternoon.



Sanctions

In order to achieve consistency and better communication with parents we have also revised our sanctions system. Any breach of school rules will result in the following procedure being followed.

- 1) Verbal warning given
- 2) Name written on the board as a second reminder
- 3) Yellow card issued—child will have time out at lunchtime and the yellow card will be sent home to inform parents.

5 yellow cards or a serious breach of school rules will result in a red card and time out at lunchtime. The red card will be sent home and parents are asked to sign and return this card to acknowledge. Any child receiving 5 red cards will be placed on a positive behaviour plan during a meeting with parents. Further information can be found on the school website under the information tab
