## Coronavirus Update

The government have now moved to a new phase in its action plan.

If you have a continuous cough and/or a high temperature however mild you must self isolate at home for 7 days. Children who present at school with new symptoms which match these will be isolated from other children and have their temperature taken. Any children with a raised temperature will be sent home.

School have not been advised to close and we are following this advice, this will remain dependent on the number of staff available as should a large number of staff need to self –isolate then we will have no choice but to close certain classes or year groups. **This measure will only be taken as a last resort.**

Should the government change its advice to include school closures, we have an action plan in place to continue to educate your children at home via our school website. If you do not have access to the internet at home please inform your child's class teacher so we can make additional provision for your family.

As the school remains open all events and trips will continue as planned until this advice changes, this includes the Mother's Day events next week and the Dearne Valley trip the following week.

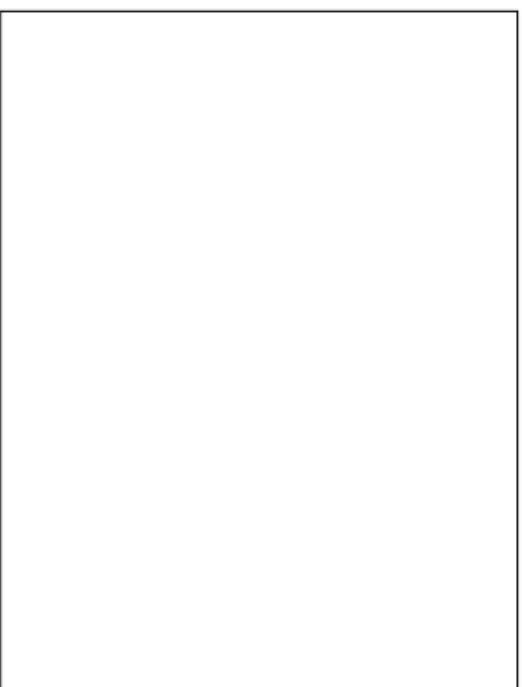
