Skills:

Unit: Knowledge and Understanding

Key questions/ experiments:

Mathematics

Number: Place Value, Addition & Subtraction, measurement.

Objectives include:

- Say the number that is one more or one less than groups of objects. Compare sets of objects.
- Count arrangements of objects
- Use number names accurately.
- Recognise some numbers.
- Match number and quantity correctly
- Order items by length or height.
