Recovery Curriculum

The Staff have worked hard to create a fun and exciting recovery curriculum for all children. This includes team building activities, drama and outside learning, art and crafts and resilience and problem solving. This is designed to help children to settle back into school as quickly as possible. Alongside this Staff have planned a catch up curriculum across the core subjects ensuring that children quickly fill any gaps in their knowledge and become more familiar with mental and quick recall facts. Once the children are fully settled staff will undertake some assessments in Reading, writing and Maths and the outcomes of these will be shared with you in our Spring reports. This way we can share with you the impact of the current lockdown and what we will be doing to close gaps for children.

School Trips

The current Coronavirus regulations do not allow for any overnight trips and thus we have had to make the following arrangement. The Year 6 trip to Standon Bowers has been moved to June 21st and the Dearne Valley Trip for the current Year 5 children has been moved to September.
