



Dear Parents,

Following the latest government guidance we are now in a position to make some final decisions about Year 6 leavers events.

Whilst the Government is planning to remove the need for bubbles in schools on July 19th it is not removing the need for children to self-isolate when coming into contact with a positive case until 16th August. The Government guidance also states that school must follow advice from public health when faced with local outbreaks such as the outbreak currently underway in Staffordshire.

After taking all these measures into account together with our wish to give parents the opportunity to be part of their child's leavers events we have organised the following events.

- 1) **Year 6 leavers Disco Wed 14th 18:00- 19:30** the disco has an Oscars theme and the staff will be in their finest outfits but children may come dressed however they feel comfortable. We will have a photo booth at the disco and children have asked if they can bring their mobile phones, although supervised during the disco we will be unable to police who is taking a photo of what so if you feel uncomfortable with phones at the disco please let school know and we will ask for them not to be brought.
- 2) **Mon 19th July** As the rest of the school bump up to their new class on this day we have organised a day of activities for the year 6 children culminating in a colour run, the children will have lots of fun but will also get very messy, old clothes only please.
- 3) **Tues 20th July 1:30pm Leavers Assembly and afternoon tea.** We will be hosting our leavers assembly in the school hall with the rest of the school presenting their tributes virtually. This means that we are able to invite parents to join us for this event with the following stipulations.
 - Max of two guests per child, **you must book your place in advance via text stating the number attending.**
 - Adults will be sat socially distanced in the hall and are asked not to mix with the children until outside.
 - Adults will be asked to wear a mask when travelling through the school building but may remove it when sat down or outside.

Following the assembly we will be having afternoon tea outside for parents and year 6 pupils following which parents may take their children home. In order to finance the above events could we please ask parents for a donation of £5 which can be paid on Parent Pay by Fri 16th July.

In addition to this children will be having transition workshops and virtual tours of their new schools. As ever in the current climate these arrangements could change should we have a school outbreak but we are all praying for a smooth end to the school year.
