We will also provide your child with a log on for EdShed which they can use to log on and practise their spelling and Maths skills at home.

Then please encourage your child to complete as many of the activities from the year group menu as they like at home, but NO LESS than 3 over the half term. This can be recorded (if appropriate) in our homework books or submitted via Teams. A new menu will be available at the start of each holiday. Homework can be done as and when you get time and offers some choice to your child too.
