Dear Parent,

We are all devastated that we have had to send our Year 5/6 bubble home with only 3 days of the school year left. It was so difficult to watch both staff and children become upset on hearing the news. Unfortunately, there was no choice, more than one positive case in the bubble has meant that we must follow Government guidance and commence self-isolation for the children. Their last contact with a positive case was Monday 12th July so their self-isolation will be up to and including Thursday 22nd July

We are very grateful that the Year 6 children were able to enjoy their leavers disco last night and I can assure you that everyone who attended had a great time. With regard to provision for year 5 and 6 over the last few days we have arranged the following.

Year 5 Children

There is lockdown work available via their TEAMS account, on transition day, Monday 19th July the pupils class teacher will call them via TEAMS at 9:30 to join in with an activity with their new class. They will then have a number of transition activities to complete that day from their new teacher.

Year 6 Children

There is lockdown work available via their TEAMS account. Staff will set an assignment for pupils to create a leaving message to be completed by Monday. Staff will then collate these for all the children and share them so the children may keep them as a leaving book.

On Tuesday morning staff will deliver the following to Year 6, Leaver's hoodie, Record of Achievement, Leavers book, school present and afternoon tea. We will then post on TEAMS the leavers play and messages from staff and pupils which were due to be shared during assembly for pupils to watch with their families.

At 9:30 on Tuesday there will be a class TEAMS call for all pupils to have an opportunity to chat to each other and teachers. Teacher will also be available on TEAMS all day for pupils should they wish to talk.

Any money paid for events will be refunded via ParentPay.

We wish everyone a safe and peaceful summer and look forward to seeing the year 5 children in September. For our Year 6 children please remember you will always be part of our school family, please come back and visit us and let us know how you are doing.
