

Welcome to Nursery!

Welcome to Nursery! What a great start we have had to our year. The children have settled in brilliantly and are really getting used to their new routines. We are very impressed.

This letter should provide you with all of the information you should need at the beginning of the year.



Classroom doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.50am so that our routines can begin. Once doors have been closed, children will need to enter school via the main reception. At this time of year, please bear with us whilst we are getting to you.

Here is a reminder of what a day in Nursery will look like:

- 8.40:** Enter and register
- 8.55:** Worship (when ready)
- 9.15:** Teacher input for reading, writing or maths
- 9.25:** Busy Bee time in the continuous provision
- 10.15:** Fine Motor Skills
- 10.20:** Snack and social time—communication and language focus.
- 10.30:** Phonics
- 10.45:** Adult led groups for reading, writing or maths and continuous provision activities
- 11.30:** Whole Class Reading/shared reading and getting ready for lunch or home
- 11.45:** Lunch / Morning children home
- 12.40:** Register
- 1.00:** Topic session/PE (this could have a PSHE, RE, expressive arts or understanding the world focus)
- 2.00:** Reading and Rhyme Time
- 2.30:** Tidy up time
- 2.40:** Whole Class Reading/shared reading
- 2.50:** Prayers and organisation ready for home
- 3.00:** Home time

PE

Nursery have PE on **Tuesdays** so please ensure that your child comes into school in full PE kit on this day. Children are unable to wear any earrings for PE so please could you ensure that they are taken out on this day. Staff will need written permission to take these out.

Home/school correspondence

If you haven't already, please check your emails (also your junk file) for a link to connect you to Class Dojo so you can keep up to date with messages straight from your teacher, as well as seeing the dojos that your child has received.

If you are not linked up to Evidence Me already and you have handed your email address in, you will receive an email in the next week to connect to that too, so please keep an eye out for that. If we don't have your email, please hand this in to your child's class teacher either at the door or written in your child's planner. Observations will begin once baselines have been completed.

Baselines

The first three weeks of Nursery is all about getting to know each other and understanding classroom systems. Staff will also be carrying out activities with your child to get a 'baseline' of where your child is which will help us to plan our Busy Bee activities in the continuous provision and next steps for your child's learning journey. Once baselines have been completed your child will begin to bring a library book home from school which we encourage you to share together each day.

Uniform

Please can you ensure that children's names are in ALL school uniform and coats. We have already had some lost property!

Consent

Please can we also remind you to sign and bring in the photograph consent form and read and sign the Email and Internet Safety policy. You will find this at the front of your child's reading diary. Once these have been collected, we can then begin sharing photographs via Facebook.

Homework

Homework menu's will be given out during the first week of each half term. Homework will be collected in during the final week of each half term so that we can celebrate the efforts that the children have gone to. Children are asked to choose AT LEAST three things from the menu to complete.

Reading

All children have new reading diaries, which also have lots of helpful information in the back on maths facts, spellings and sounds we will be covering this year. Children will need to read at least three times per week. Each time your child reads/you share a book, sign their reading record and they will receive dojos. Reading and enjoying books at home will have a huge impact on your child's learning and development at school. We do not expect your child to read the whole book in one sitting, a few pages each time is fine.

Water bottles

To enable your child to access a drink in school, they will need their own water bottle with their name on it. Please make sure this is in school EVERY DAY.

Injury on arrival forms

If your child has suffered an injury at home, you will be asked to fill in an 'injury on arrival form' which are available from the nursery classroom. Please can we ask that you fill one of these in and pass it to the class teacher so that we are aware of where the incident has occurred.
