This will help to develop their comprehension skills and have a better understanding of the text. We will be sharing a variety of texts related to our Wonderful World topic and helping your child to foster a love of books. We are grateful for your support with this. Please also practise spellings on Edshed and in your child's spelling log ready for their test on Friday.

### Added Extras:

Please encourage your child to complete as many activities from the menu as they can, but **NO LESS than 3** over the half term. Please record the activities in your child's homework book, this can include photographs. We will ask for homework books handed in during the last week of each half term, in order for us to share and celebrate this learning.
