COVID Update

We continue to see an increase in COVID numbers across the school.

Could I please ask that if your child shows any symptoms or if they are a close contact of someone who is positive they test with a lateral flow test before coming into school. This is particularly important in years 5 and 6 where we have some vulnerable children.

From Monday 17th Jan people self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative on both day 5 and day 6 and do not have a temperature, from Monday, 17th January. (They can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.)

Individuals who are still positive on their rapid lateral flow tests must stay in isolation until they have had two consecutive negatives tests taken on separate days.

Community Code of Conduct

We are very lucky at this school to have so many wonderful supportive parents. We have recently though had a few incidents of abusive and threatening behaviour. This will not be tolerated and should they happen on the school grounds the individuals will be removed and banned. We do not have powers to stop this behaviour outside of the school grounds but we do report all incidents to the local police. It is unacceptable to allow our children to witness bad language and violence and we will do everything we can to prevent this.
