This service is available Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm, excluding bank holidays, standard text costs apply.

Please also make sure that your child is registered with a local General Practitioner (GP). You can do this by registering at the GP surgery in your area. We also recommend that you register your child(ren) with a local dentist. If you are unsure of dentists that you can register with, the dental advice line. They will help you to find a local dentist that is taking on new patients; please contact them on 0300 123 0981 or via the NHS Website.
