

Set Menu: Daily reading, Spelling Shed, Maths Shed

We are asking children to read **at least 3 times** each week and for parents to record this in their child's reading record. Listening to children read will enable them to practise their sounds and develop their reading fluency. Please talk to your child about their book, the pictures inside and what might happen next. This will help to develop their comprehension skills and have a better understanding of the text. We will be sharing a variety of texts related to our topic and helping your child to foster a love of books. We will also be assigning your child Maths and Spelling assignments on EdShed to be practised as often as possible. Your child will be tested on their spellings each Friday. Thank you for your support with this.

Added Extras:

Please encourage your child to complete as many activities from the menu as they can, but **NO LESS than 3** over the half term. Please record the activities in your child's homework book, this can include photographs. We will ask for homework books handed in during the last week of each half term, in order for us to share and celebrate this learning.
