



Dear parents/carers,

As we move into the final weeks, we wanted to share key information for all of the Year 6 leavers events that are coming up.

As well as the Y6 residential to Standon Bowers (11<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup> July) we have lots happening in school, all of which is outlined below:

- 1) **Year 6 Play- Shakespeare Rocks Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July: 1.45-3pm and 6-7pm.** This will take place in the school hall and tickets are not required. If you are bringing young children, we would ask that you attend the afternoon performance, all siblings will have the opportunity to watch the play during the school day. Please note that **all Y6 pupils need to be back at school for 5.30pm** in order to get ready for the evening performance.
- 2) **Year 6 Bee Active event day Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July.** As the rest of the school bump up to their new class on this day, we have organised a day of activities for the year 6 children culminating in a Colour Run, the children will have lots of fun but will also get very messy, old clothes only please, preferably a white t-shirt.
- 3) **Year 6 leavers Disco Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 6-7.30pm.** The disco has an Oscars theme and the staff will be in their finest outfits but children may come dressed however they feel comfortable. Children will have food provided during the evening and we will have a photo booth. Children have asked if they can bring their mobile phones, although supervised during the disco we will be unable to police who is taking a photo of what, so if you do feel uncomfortable with phones at the disco, please let school know and we will ask for them not to be brought.
- 4) **Leavers Assembly tea and biscuits Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 1.30-3pm.** We will be hosting our leavers assembly and awards in the school hall with the rest of the school presenting their tributes at intervals throughout. Following the assembly we will be having tea and biscuits outside for parents and Year 6 pupils, following which parents may take their children home.

In order to finance the above events could we please ask parents for a donation of £5 which can be paid on Parent Pay by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July.

In addition to this, children will be having transition visits to their new high schools over the week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> July. We look forward to celebrating our wonderful Y6 pupils with you all.
