Mrs Pointon is not at all sure she can run 26.2 miles so we will be encouraging children to track her progress using the TCS London marathon APP so she is not tempted to stop!



Beginning and end of the school day

I have taken a call today from a representative for a group of our neighbours complaining about the issue of parking, especially at the start of the school day. Our neighbours are upset that parents are parking on the pavements, blocking the roads, speeding away down busy streets and, in particular that when they have asked people to move, some of the responses have been uncooperative and occasionally antagonistic.

Our neighbours know that this is a minority of people who pick up from school, but it is making life quite stressful for residents, some of whom are elderly and vulnerable people. I really want to be a good neighbour to those in our community – concern for other people is something we try to instil in all our pupils. Please can I reiterate our responsibilities for pick-ups:

- **ALL** parents are asked to park responsibly in the neighbouring streets taking care to not block driveways or disabled access.
- **PLEASE** do not park on the yellow lines immediately in front of the school.
- Please keep to the speed limit on the surrounding street

I appreciate that this may mean that drop off and pick up takes an extra minute or two but it means that your children are safe, community problems are minimised and we are re-established as good neighbours which is infinitely preferable to the current position. I urge everyone to support us in this matter for the good of the whole community.

<u>Class Dojo</u>

Thank you to all the parents who have signed up to class dojo we had over 90% take up. We will be setting alternate Maths and English homework every week on class dojo for children to complete. They can hand this in electronically by uploading it to portfolios or by bringing a paper copy into school for their class teacher. You can also see the dojo's awarded to your child in class and are able to award a limited number of dojos yourself.



As well as weekly homework can we please stress the importance of regular reading at home, children should be reading at least 3x a week as well as practising their spellings and completing their homework.

School Competitions

During the Autumn term we will be choosing a cross country squad and a netball team to play against other Newcastle schools in the Sports leagues. We have listened to parental feedback and now run these clubs well in advance of the competition for children in years 3-6 to ensure that the children are well prepared for these competitions. Teams will be chosen from children who regularly attend the school clubs.

School Foodbank

As a school we are very proud to have had a foodbank facility in our Reception area for the past two years. We have an ever-increasing number of families who use this facility on a weekly basis.
