Home Learning

In order to support children with their home learning we have a number of Apps which they are able to access at home. Children from Year 1 upwards have access to the EdShed app which supports them with their spelling and children in Year 2 upwards have access to the Times Tables Rockstars App. Both apps are available to download from your App store and the children's log in details can be found in their reading diaries. All children would also benefit from using the White Rose Maths App which does not require a log in. Nothing is a substitute for daily reading with an adult, but we know the children really enjoy using these Apps. We also have clubs to support these areas.
