Dear Parents,

I have had confirmation from some teachers today that they will be participating in a union strike on:

Wednesday 1st March

The strike will affect the majority of classes and following government guidance we as a school have completed a risk assessment to determine how many children we can supervise in the building. This is based on the number of staff available on the day and the fact that staff will be supported by Mrs Pointon and Mrs Booth.

As a result of this, I can confirm that school will only be open for those children in

Nursery

Year 1

Year 3 and 4

Children with an EHCP (unfortunately not their siblings) or families who are classed as vulnerable. These parents will be notified by text before the end of Tues to inform them that the school is open for them to attend on Wednesday 1st March.

On the day, all children in Reception, Year 2 plus any child entitled to a free school meal will have one provided for them. There is no need to book this meal in advance, the packed lunch will be sent home with them at the end of the school day on Tuesday.

I appreciate this is very difficult for parents and you should rightly raise your concerns, these should be directed to the local MP, Mr Aaron Bell
