Dear Parents,

I have had confirmation from some teachers today that they will be participating in a union strike on:

Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July

Following government guidance, we as a school have completed a risk assessment to determine how many children we can supervise in the building. This is based on the number of staff available on the day and the fact that staff will be supported by Mrs Pointon and Mrs Booth.

As a result of this, I can confirm that school will be closed on both days for children in

Year 2

All children with an EHCP (unfortunately not their siblings) or families who are classed as vulnerable will also be invited into school. These parents will be notified by text before the end of the week to inform them that the school is open for them to attend.

On the day, all children in Year 2 will have a packed lunch provided for them. There is no need to book this meal in advance, the packed lunch will be sent home with them at the end of the school day on Tuesday and Thursday.
